Weightlifting New Zealand Sport Integrity & Child Protection Policies

As we prepare for the upcoming NZ National Secondary Schools Weightlifting Championships, Weightlifting New Zealand reminds all athletes, coaches, managers, officials, parents, caregivers, supporters, and any other members of travelling parties of their responsibility to uphold the highest standards of conduct throughout the event.

The safety and wellbeing of all participants, particularly children and young people, is our highest priority. All members of travelling parties are expected to be familiar with and comply with Weightlifting New Zealand's Sport Integrity Policies, including the Child Protection Policy and Child Safeguarding Policy.

These policies outline the expected standards of behaviour, safeguarding responsibilities, reporting processes, and safe practices relating to:

- Child protection and safeguarding
- Transport and travel
- Overnight stays
- Changing rooms
- Taking and storing images
- Appropriate conduct and reporting concerns
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All travelling party members are required to read these policies prior to attending the championships.
