# Information Bulletin

The 2024 United Masters World Weightlifting Championships will be held for the very first time in Suva - Fiji, from September 23<sup>rd</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup>. The UMWF vision is to embrace every individual master lifter from around the world – united. This event gives individual lifters an opportunity to compete in a world event. The UMWF is delighted to extend an opportunity to the 30 to 34 years age group also to be part of this world event.

# **Competition Rules and Regulations**

This World Championships will follow the Technical and Competition Rules and Regulations (TCRR) of the International Weightlifting Federation (IWF).

# **Terms and Conditions of Participation**

- Must participate in the Event at their own risk and take all reasonable measures to protect themselves from any risk.
- Must undertake full moral and financial responsibility with regard to their health and wellness and in case of accidents or damages.

- Acknowledge and agree that neither the UMWF nor the OC shall arrange any insurance connected with the

- Must irrevocably release UMWF and OC (and their respective members, officers, employees, etc.) from liability for any loss, injury or damage that they may suffer in relation to their participation in the event.

#### **Awards**

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to competitors in each bodyweight category and age groups for both men and women in the **total only**.

## **Competition Venue**

The competition venue is the Vodafone Arena. At this stage we are planning to have 3 main stages with 8 warm up platforms for each stage available. 24 platforms in all.





#### **Training Venue**

Training will be available to all individual participants prior to the competition on a timetable basis if necessary. 40 platforms will be available for training. The training venue is also within the Vodafone arena.

#### **Barbells/Weights Equipment**

Equipment for the World Championships will be ZKC.

#### **Doping Control**

Doping control will be conducted during the competition.

#### Accreditation fees.

All participants competing must pay USD\$150 each. This sum must be paid online when you register.

#### **Travelling Documents & Visas**

Travelling to Fiji is very easy. The documentation required is a valid passport. Below you will find a list of countries which have visa exemptions. You will receive an entry visa upon arrival. All other countries not in the list, will require visa.

For those individuals who may be travelling through New Zealand or Australia to get to Fiji, you must check as to whether you require a transit visa for these two countries.
